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1. Official Opening

The meeting is officially opened at 09:00 CET 03 /12 /2011.

2. Presentation of Committees

2.1 Events and Activities Committee

Representatives: Carolin Ziegler, Flavius Sirbu

There is a bit difficult situation in the Events and Activities Committee, because they have lack of active members.

This year tasks are:

- **A new formula for the Entity Ranking List**

It should include a ratio of organisers and participants and should have an increased flexibility concerning participants and the scientific level. The problem is that the actual formula has to static rules what brings unequal assessments. Which of the proposals will be the best has to be discussed.

- **EGEA Database**

The Database includes all activities organized by EGEA entities. It is divided by Region, Entity, Activity Contact Persons, the e-mail address of the event organizer and specific information. It will be a helpful tool for creating the Entity Ranking List and also very useful for regional matters and the Board of EGEA (These data are essential for EGEA Activity Report). The Database format allows better overview and easy access to data. The Events and Activities Committee is the background supporter of the Database. Regional Assistants agree on working on the database together with the Events and Activities Committee. All events have to be stated at the website. If entity decides to organize an activity, event coordinator must inform the Events and Activities Committee and fill in the form for the Database. A monthly provision of data will help to maintain the Database and to monitor EGEA activities.

- **FAQ**

All questions are answered. Just a fancy layout is missing at time. It will be published on the entity page of the Events and Activities Committee. Also it will be provided in the EGEA Newsletter and at the next regional meetings.

- **Best practice manual**

It will be published in the second half of the EGEA year. A request has sent to former congress organisers.

- **Stress calendar**

Will be finished in the second half of the EGEA year.

2.2 Communication and Media Committee

Representatives: Sander van der Klei, André Berger

The aim of the Communication and Media Committee is to support EGEA and all Entities and Events with promotion material like videos, posters, etc.

- **EGEA Newsletter**

Sander van der Klei/EGEA Utrecht, André Berger/EGEA Trondheim, Joanna Wawryniewicz/EGEA Warszawa are working on this project.

The new Newsletter will be published monthly with actual updates of events, committees' projects, administrative news, gossips and a some fun stuff.

- **New Promotion Video**

André Berger/EGEA Trondheim and Franziska Häring/EGEA Augsburg will work on this project.

Some aims are to show social skills, present activities and what is EGEA about.

- **EGEA Videos**

André Berger/EGEA Trondheim, Franziska Häring/EGEA Augsburg, Laurentiu Mares/EGEA Timisoara and Sander will work on EGEA Videos.

There will be special videos about the congresses and several EGEA events.

- **Facebook**

Dan Dorocain/EGEA Bucharest, André Berger/EGEA Trondheim, Marius Vidac/EGEA Timisoara and Franziska Häring/EGEA Augsburg are in authority of the Facebook page.

One task is to bring the unofficial and the official page together.

The visibility of committees and the viewability for sponsors have to be improved in Facebook. The alteration of Facebook will go on this year.

- **New Leaflets**

Dan Dorocian/EGEA Bucharest and Laurentiu Mares/EGEA Timisoara will work on new leaflets about EGEA.

The old ones are not up-to-date. There will be a new layout and new content.

- **EGEA Calendar**

Cristian Matei/EGEA Timisoara, André Berger/EGEA Trondheim, Claudiu Balcu/EGEA Timisoara and Franziska Häring/EGEA Augsburg are in charge of the new calendar.

They will work on the Photo Competition for the calendar 2013. In 2012 there are two calendars - one from the White Sea Geomorphology seminar, other one is EGEA 25 years. White Sea calendar printed and sent to the participants and official partners of EGEA (from the event's budget). The EGEA Calendar will be available as *pdf document on the website. The theme is 25 Years of EGEA.

- **New EGEA Poster**

Dan Dorocain/EGEA Bucharest, André Berger/EGEA Trondheim and Franziska Häring/EGEA Augsburg will work on a new poster and posters for events if needed.

- **Wikipedia Article**

Henning Kronen/EGEA Aachen will take care of it.

There has to be some improvements. After that the translations phase will start.

- **EGEA Song**

Sander van der Klei/EGEA Utrecht will work this year on a new EGEA song. He is expressing possibilities ☺

- **BoE Xmas Card**

André Berger/EGEA Trondheim and Joanna Wawrynowicz/EGEA Warszawa worked on this project. It was send per mail to all entities and partners of EGEA.

- **New Stickers**

Dan Dorocain/EGEA Bucharest and Laurentiu Mares/EGEA Timisoara are in charge of new stickers.

They will create different layouts to make fancy stickers.

- **Comments**

- A problem for organizing committee live-meeting is the distance between the members.

- The Communication and Media Committee has a lot of running and planned projects with other committees (for example, the Career Fair with the Fundraising Committee).

- During the meeting some new projects for Communication and Media Committee came up: new EGEA templates, new EGEA slides, new EGEA presentation.

2.3 Entity Support Committee

Representatives: Grzegorz Łach, Maximilian Gosa

The Entity Support Committee has members from all regions. The main aim of the committee is to support less active entities, new entities and candidating entities. All entities are divided to the committee members.

- **Welcome Package**

One important point is the review of the Welcome Package. Currently there are too many documents which are not essential for the first contact with prospective entities. There should be new Welcome Letter as well (more fancy, designed in cooperation with the Communication and Media Committee).

- **Entity Survey**



It will be created by Regional Assistances in cooperation with the Events and Activities Committee (using new Database). Execution date is in February 2012. With the use of the new Database it will be faster and more convenient. For less-active entities there will be another small survey.

- **Other projects**

- There is a Road Trip planned. Destinations are regions with fewer entities or without entities at all. The idea is to find Geography students, to get in contact with them and try to get in contact with the Universities which have Geography Departments or Geography-related Departments (for example, Tourism).

2.4 Human Resources and Trainings Committee

Representatives: Anna Tołoczko, Christoph Götz

This year Human Resources and Trainings Committee is a motivated group. At time, the committee is in the transition period. Catalina is still the Speaker. But the future plans are in hand of new members.

- **Trainings**

There will be a second edition of the FINE trainers event (Re-FINE). The application for the Youth in Action Grant will be submitted in February.

- **Collection of Games**

The collection will be published on the website during the year. At time, the committee is working on the second chapter - Team Building.

- **Guidelines for Trainers**

The Human Resources and Trainings Committee is working on the manual for trainers.

- **Trainings at Congresses**

The Committee will make an open call for trainings at the Annual Congress 2012 like it worked out at the Annual Congress 2011.

- **English Summer School in Malta (Board of EGEA proposal)**

EGEA Malta will organize English Summer School. The duration of the Summer School will be two weeks (pre-dates are the end of September). Approximate number of participants – 60-80. The amount of places is too much for EGEA. EGEA will offer places to partners. There will be classes with different levels of English; all classes will be highly connected to Geography. The Organization Team has about 5 organizers. They are all certified English teachers. EGEA Malta will apply for a grant (Grundtvig Program).

- **Comments and ideas:**

- EGEA needs a better Promotion of trainings;
- A more visible work of the committee (keep updating Committee page and blog);
- A Games-Blog in the forum;

- A work-plan for the next years;
- To join Trainers Forum where all student organizations can participate;
- A Specific Training Event (a whole week with different topics);
- A Training Event for Entity Contact Persons;
- It might be good to make consecutive online trainings (like 2-3 days, each day about 45 minutes).

2.5 Website Committee

Representative: Sven Vanderhaegen

The main task of this year is finalizing new EGEA website. Some hard facts about the new website:

- There will be a link to the old website at the new one;
- Everybody will have a personal homepage and a personal calendar;
- There will be a new EGEA map;
- There will be the possibility to upload theses etc.

Currently the Board of EGEA and the Website Committee is trying to find finances for finalizing new website.

2.6 European Geographer

Representative: Tobias Michl

At time there are two chief editors: Tobias Michl/EGEA Augsburg and Inge Wiegenkamp/EGEA Amsterdam. Two editions are intended to be published: The Water edition and the edition about the Scientific Symposium 2011. Other projects are:

- **Creation/Improvement of manuals**
 - The European Geographer team will work on an author manual
 - European Geographer Guidelines
 - Editors manual (new)
 - Chief editors manual (new)
 - Layout manual (new)
- **Improvement of promotion of the magazine**

The team will set on focus on the promotion, which means:

- More presence at the website and at the congresses

- The possibility of an independent European Geographer website
 - The Entity Support Committee will send the 5th and 6th issue together with the Welcome Package in order to promote EGEA magazine
 - Improvement of an European Geographer Facebook Page
 - Cooperation with the Scientific Committee
- **The 9th Edition**

This edition will be referring to the 2nd Organizing and Strategy Meeting which will take place during the cultural seminar “Many cultures 4 Europe” in La Rochelle in July 2012. EGEA got a grant for organizing this cultural seminar. In the grant included the budget for printing European Geographer (500 EUR). This issue should be devoted to seminar’s topic.

- **Other**
 - The last edition was quite successful. Especially due to the fact, that the scientific level was high, there where 20 extra orders.
 - Another important point is the improvement of the cover quality.
 - The next edition will be printed in Utrecht again.
 - It might be a good idea to work together with the Fundraising Committee for searching sponsors.

2.7 Scientific Committee

Representative: Sandra Sosnowski

- **Workshop manual**

The workshop manual is finished. The next workshop leaders will get it to improve the quality of EGEA workshops.

- **Scientific Symposium**

The Scientific Symposium will get a new structure at the next Annual Congress. There will be four thematic panels, in each two presenters. All in all there will be eight presenters in two hours. The attendants can switch between the panels and to attend presentations of their interest. The presentations and presenters will be published in the Annual Congress program so that the participants can make a choice in advance.

- **Providing university excursions in EGEA**

Field trips offer exclusive opportunity for students how to improve knowledge and how to obtain necessary experience. Not everywhere and every time they are fully crowded by students from organizing university and thus these empty places would be passed to interested EGEAns.

- **Scientific Exhibition**

This project will be implemented in cooperation with the Events and Activities Committee, the Communication and Media Committee and the Board of EGEA. It will be mixed up with an EGEA Live Exhibition, where people can present all their activities. The idea is that a combination of different type of posters (activity posters, scientific posters) is more interesting.

- **Other ideas and comments**

- The Scientific Committee has the idea to put information about local Geography Departments (or Universities/Departments hosting EGEA entities) at entity pages. There could be different possibilities: to ask University for any kind of support (room, printing, fundraising etc.) and instead to promote University at the entity page on EGEA website (like small advertisement with the list of master programs and links to the University website, for example). It could be useful to get contact between Universities with Geography Departments and EGEA Europe. The contact can be established by sending a Welcome Letter or a Letter of Interest on behalf of Board of EGEA. This can be a way to get sponsorship to EGEA Europe or to local EGEA entities (to get free flyers, or money for organizing events and even participating in events etc.). Different sponsorship packages can be offered to Universities.
- **The EUROGEO Event in Dublin (May 2012):**
 - Cooperation between EUROGEO, EGEA and EGEA Alumni & Dinosaurs;
 - It will be a four days event. For EGEAns there is a reduced fee and the opportunity for cheap hosting;
 - It is a good opportunity to find sponsors or job for EGEAns;
 - Last EUROGEO event was about 70 to 80 €.
- **E-Lecture** on the 26th of January:
 - It will be the first EGEA e-lecture with a physical geographical topic (and 3rd EGEA e-lecture in total). The topic is „Rock glaciers“. Lecturer is Prof. Ivar Berthling, University of Trondheim.

2.8 Fundraising Committee

Representative: Claudia Iordache (via skype)

Aims of this year:

- **Advice Entities regarding fundraising**

The target is to provide ideas and initiatives for fundraising for EGEA Europe and engage EGEAns in fundraising to raise money for EGEA Europe.

- **EGEA Career Fair**

Main Goals are to engage the committee members into an activity that will bring money for EGEA and benefits for EGEAns in general. Also, to raise the popularity of the Fundraising Committee in order to



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encourage future members to join the committee and the awareness about EGEA among the business sector. Benefits are: engaged committee members; EGEA will get money from companies and EGEA will give the opportunity to EGEAns to get in contact with companies. Another point is that EGEA will be presented to companies in a professional way and it can be a pillar for lasting relationships with the business sector.

But a lot of work should be done to organize Career Fair like marketing analysis, preparing the list of companies, making sponsorship package, contacting companies, negotiating etc. More details about that project will be published on the forum.

2.9 Comments

Committees and Facebook

Facebook is the most common communication platform in EGEA. The idea is to make EGEA more visible on Facebook. Several ideas came up. Like that all information about committees projects should be shown on Facebook. The problem is that if this happens, members will not move to our main communication platform – EGEA website. Because of this, just important calls, videos and photos with a direct link to the EGEA website should be shown in the official group on Facebook, to attract people to go to the EGEA website.

But it might be good to make promotion on Facebook for committees to get more EGEAns for their work. So, it might be good if committees have a Facebook group. But for that we need guidelines: promotion of all committees should be done the same way, following guidelines.

If the committee decides to open a private group on Facebook, it can also be a good option better communication. But this way, it is also necessary to keep the discussion on EGEA website and put all necessary links on Facebook page.

In the end, it is up to committee team to decide how they can work at best.

3. Regional Assistants

The Regional Assistants have to build a bridge between Contact Persons and the Board of EGEA. They are focussing on a steady contact to entities and working on Entity Survey and Contact Person Day at Regional Congresses.

3.1 Regional e-meetings

At the **Western e-meeting** were many discussions. Three of 26 entities were not present, but three candidating entities were present.

The **Eastern e-meeting** was quite long. Sixteen of 24 entities were present. There are a lot of activities planned in the Eastern Region this year.

At the **Euromed e-meeting** were a lot of discussions. Three entities were not present. On a local level the members are much more active than on international level. The lack of finances is the biggest issue of the region.

At the **North & Baltic e-meeting** were eight out of nine entities. There is a good communication, also due to the fact that there were many Contact Person changes.

3.2 Database proposal (see also 2.1)

The main idea is to have all basic information about entities and its activities in one digital document. This information should be collected by the Regional Assistants. The Events and Activities Committee will be in charge of maintaining Database. It will be permanently updated.

3.3 CP Day

The CP Day is a good opportunity to enhance relationships between Contact Persons of the same region,

to share ideas and experiences. This year it will be a one day session lead by Regional Contact Persons and Regional Assistants. A main point will be the knowledge transfer and trainings for Contact Persons.

4. Refund of this meeting

The Meeting will be refundend maximum by 50 €. Everyone will get the same amount of money. Please send the application and all necessary documents as fast as possible to Sanne Heijt, EGEA Secretariat Director.

5. Congresses

- Western Regional Congress, 26th - 30th March 2012
- North & Baltic Regional Congress, 19th - 24th April 2012
- Eastern Regional Congress, 26th - 30th April 2012
- Euromed- Congress, 2nd - 6th May 2012
- Annual Congress, 10th - 15th September 2012

The organisation team of Eastern Regional Congress changed from EGEA Szeged to EGEA Budapest, because of some financial problems in EGEA Szeged. As EGEA Budapest is candidating entity and does not know much about EGEA congresses, the organizing team has a full support from the Regional Assistants, the Events and Activities Committee and the Board of EGEA. Additionally the next Events and Activities Committee meeting will be held up in March in Budapest to check how it is going with organization and to help when its needed. Moreover, EGEA Budapest has a full support from the University of Budapest.

With other Regional Congresses everything is going well, following the established work-plan.

6. Open Sphere

6.1 New Formula for Entity Ranking List

There are several proposals for new formula for the Entity Ranking List. One question is, if it is important to bring a scientific component in the formula. Good events without a scientific part can also take a lot of efforts to organize. One important point is the internationality and the possibility that all EGEAns can join an event. To measure this point it is important to count the international participants of each event. In total, important parameters for new formula are:

- Number of Participants
- Duration
- Internationality
- Hosting Statutory Meeting (yes or no)
- Scientific Level (?)

It is indispensable to make a new formula because the diversity of new event categories increased. For that

the new formula should be count as easy as possible.

6.2 Communication Board of EGEA – Entity Support Committee

The idea is to make the process of establishing entities smoother and to avoid too much bureaucracy. When Entity Support Committee or Board of EGEA get a request from new entity or candidating entity to accept its Motivation Letter, the request is published on the Entity Support Committee forum. After a 2-days discussion, Entity Support Committee and Board of EGEA approve / disapprove the request. In case of approving, candidating entity gets status of nominated entity and opens its page on the website.

6.3 Scientific Sessions at Regional Congresses

The Board of EGEA thinks about to have a Scientific Session at one of Regional Congresses. However, it is up to organisers to take the decision on this. It can be a small Scientific Session and will not need that much work.

Another point to improve scientific level of EGEA activities can be to enhance the excursion's scientific level.

6.4 Board of EGEA / Regional Contact Person division next years

From next year the Regional Contact Persons together with Regional Assistants (one per each region) will work just on regional affairs. EGEA administrative matters will be the task of the Board of EGEA.

6.5 ESRI Announcement

Soon (in the next two months) the download link to download a free version of ArcGIS is available. But, there will be still the possibility to order CDs. To improve the work between ESRI and EGEA there will be in future a separate ESRI Contact Person in Utrecht with a close contact to the Secretariat Director and ESRI office. To work on the providing of ESRI software it is too much work for the Secretariat Director. It is also necessary that there is a person that has some knowledge in ArcGIS. The requests about the software will be collected and sent to ESRI monthly. In the future the subscription will be on the EGEA website, after that the interested persons will get a download link to the ESRI page. So EGEA members have the opportunity to get a free version of ArcGIS!

Another topic is if there are problems with local ESRI offices it is very important to contact the Secretariat Director. He/She will be able to mediate a solution via the European ESRI office.

From now it is obligatory to have a workshop leader from ESRI at the Annual Congresses.

6.6 EGEA Career Fair

The EGEA Career Fair is a proposal by the Fundraising Committee.

Discussion:

- The main discussion is that it is a very big project. At time it is unclear if companies will join the Fair. And if there are too less companies it will be a bad reputation for EGEA. We can lose possible sponsors.
- But the congress place of the Annual Congress 2012 brings a good opportunity.
- We have to do some research about the possibility of a Career Fair this year. There should be a

questionnaire for EGEAns and also an analysis of the market. It can be really interesting for all people if there are companies that offer job opportunities for Geographers.

- But at time we can not offer anything to potential companies. EGEA is a very small association and we don't have that much money.

- To offer the opportunity to external participants is not that good, because it should be a Career Fair for Geographers. The idea is to show the business sector to EGEAns. And it is not a point of too less participants. There are 200 at the Annual Congress.

- A trial of a Career Fair at a one of the Regional Congresses does not work out. They are too small. Utrecht tried to do it last year at the Western Regional Congress. At the end there was just one presentation from a company.

- It will be good to get inspiration by our partners, like IFISO, BEST etc.

- If we have enough companies to organise a Career Fair, it can be a good entry for new sponsors. Also with a look on a potential fee, we can earn some money.

- Jelle Gulmans/EGEA Utrecht will give the experiences of the Western Regional Congress organisers to the Fundraising Committee.

To sum up, all present people agreed that first we need more data and should take a small research first:

- 1) make a questionnaire and send it to EGEAns;
- 2) marketing analysis, list of companies;
- 3) sponsorship package (translation into different languages);
- 4) sending proposals to companies, contacting companies;
- 5) if we find out that we get at appropriate number of companies, we confirm Career Fair to Congress organizers and start promotion campaign.

6.7 EGEA 25th Birthday Weekend

All in all there are 6 persons (Alejandro Martin/EGEA Barcelona, David Parent Golobardes/EGEA Barcelona, Jelle Gulmans/EGEA Utrecht, Esther Murk/EGEA Utrecht, Grzegorz Łach/EGEA Warszawa and Ewa Koprowska/EGEA Warszawa) involved into organisation (from the three founding entities – Utrecht, Warszawa, Barcelona). The event will take place in Poland, from the 13th to 16th April 2012.

6.8 Committees

The idea by the Board of EGEA is to have an earlier application for committees (right after the regional congresses). There might be the possibility of a Committee Fair organised at the Regional Congresses. However, the main application will be of course at the Annual Congress during the Committee Fair.

Discussion:

- This is maybe a too long time for the application period (April – September).

- Maybe we can have two application periods to gain more members: first – at Regional Congresses; second – at Annual Congress.

- It might be better to have a better promotion of the committees in general, throughout the year.

- The problem is that we have a big summer gap, that's why the idea came up to make it earlier.
- One solution how to attract EGEAns to work in the committees can be to make more promotion at Regional Congresses. To prove one hour to present the committees in an informal way in the evening of the regional congresses is not that big deal.

6.9 How to make a faster transition period after the AC?

Discussion:

- A good solution to fasten up the transition period will be a manual to have a standardised transition. Another point is to push the former speakers and secretaries to take care about smooth transition.
- It is not that easy to make a faster transition period for committees. E.g. the Human Resources and Trainings Committee organised the FINE event, they were busy with organising and could not focus on the transition.
- If you have a look at the committee's year: it is 1 1/2 months of transition, 1 1/2 months of teambuilding and 8 to 9 months of working time.
- It is important to finish the transition period as soon as possible after Annual Congress so that the committees can outline its projects for the upcoming year. The Board of EGEA need this information to apply for grants (many applications have deadlines in October-November).
- It is better to make no rules for transition. But we can try to make committee fairs in between the year like e-lectures, after that people can join committees and try to work in a committee.

So there could be an open subscription period twice a year. Maybe it would be better to have no fixed period and people can join committees at any time. But the best solution is still to find members face-to-face at the Annual Congress. Still, the best promotion is to have good and attractive projects.

6.10 Euromed region

Problems of the Region are the distances, the language barrier and a less international participation.

This year in the Euromed Region will be another big event, the English Summer School in Malta. Then there will be a second Organisation and Strategy Committee Meeting in La Rochelle.

The 2nd Organisation and Strategic Committee meeting is in La Rochelle, because it was the only entity from Euromed region that responded positive and in time. The idea was to strengthen the Euromed Region. In the Balkan Region is the regional congress, Barcelona declined.

Due to the fact we got a grant for this meeting, the travel costs will be founded up to 100€. Further there will be trainings and a cultural program.

6.11 How to get “free” money for EGEA Europe?

Many ideas came up on how to earn money for EGEA:

- **Sell sweatshirts and t-shirts with a 25-years of EGEA motto**
 - for stitched sweatshirts - it is approximately 25€ per sweater

- If there are around 100 people it is worth it!
- Especially in big entities it is easy to promote and to sell
- In Valencia motto shirts were very successful, for example
- **A lottery** is not that good idea, because of different laws in Europe. We have to be very careful with legislation issues
- An **EGEA Web shop** to sell merchandise (Communication and Media Committee has some nice ideas)
 - Is not a legal problem as long we don't make profit

- The possibility to **register at the court** to earn money from court judges - In Romania and Poland it is possible for NGOs to get two percent of the taxes
- EGEA Utrecht has **donations** by Alumni
- We can introduce a **donate button** at our website homepage
